

SFY 2018-19 GIVE RFA Questions and Responses

Question 1: The RFP states “Overtime compensation for non-sworn support or administrative positions will not be funded. This includes overtime for crime analysts and other non-sworn support positions.” The Erie County DA’s Office employs victim advocates who are paid overtime to respond to shooting victims at our trauma hospital after regular working hours in order to gather intelligence. DCJS has supported and funded this effort since GIVE I. Will overtime funding of this project still be allowable under GIVE V?

Answer: Victim advocates who are required to respond to the hospital after regular working hours to gather intelligence would not be considered support or administrative personnel, so overtime costs associated with these types of operations are permissible and would be considered.
