Introduction

Caseload size is an important measure in determining the work of the probation officer and the time that he/she has available to supervise the probationer. Complicating the discussion is the concept of workload, which is the number of work duties that correspond with *each probationer* on an officer's caseload, in addition to the supervision tasks associated each probationer. In recent years, the number of duties has grown including the taking of DNA samples, ensuring the offender's compliance, where appropriate, with the Sex Offender Registry and conducting home visits and address confirmation checks. Since not all probationers are alike, workload varies along with caseload. This suggests that weights may be assigned to each probationer to reflect the actual amount of work so that caseloads are more effectively managed. The use of actuarial assessment instruments assist the probation officer in consistently measuring the risk and need of each probationer. Actuarial assessment instruments inform the probation officer on how best to allocate resources and influence how supervision is carried out, emphasizing the quality over the quantity of contacts in changing offender behavior. In turn, the availability of statewide data on the risk and need of the probation population will influence the development of caseload standards.

The National Council on Crime and Delinquency, an organization that has conducted more than 80 workload studies over the last fifteen years offers two helpful definitions:

- *"Workload demand* is the staff time needed to complete to supervise offenders and complete required offender investigations during an average operating month.
- *Available staff time* is a computation of the staff hours available meet the workload demand exerted by the agency's service operation."

The American Probation and Parole Association (APPA) released a paper on the subject in September of 2006. Among the observations were:

- Not all offenders are alike, and vary in terms of level of risk, responsivity to intervention, and needs.
- Orders and conditions imposed by the court on probationers are not all the same. They vary not only by probationer, but by court, judge and offense.
- Not all jurisdictions are the same; statutes, and political and policy environments vary.
- Small caseloads alone are not enough, they "must be of a size that provides officers with enough time to devote to each offender to achieve supervision objectives" (p. 4).

APPA Caseload Standards

In October of 2006, the Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives conducted a survey of 58 local probation departments on their caseload models and levels. The data are presented as statewide totals and averages, and by each county as reported to the Division. Hamilton County did not provide data. The first presentation of statewide totals is in the exact format of the original survey for reference.

Highlights of the Survey

- Caseload assignments for 1924.51 officers were identified, 1372.56 (71.3%) with a Criminal Court Caseload.
- More officers carried specialized caseloads (60.1%) than general caseloads; which consist of pre-trial release, DWI, Sex Offenders, High Risk Offenders, Domestic Violence, or the Intensive Supervised Probation or Probation Eligible Diversion Programs, among other types.
- Juvenile officers tended to supervise generalized caseloads (67.2%).
- 2404.5 full-time equivalent officers (FTE) were identified as having investigation or supervisory responsibilities.
 - 385.75 officers are assigned to conduct only investigations (74% Criminal Court only; 19% Family Court only; 7% do both).
 - 1318.25 officers do *only* Family or Criminal Court supervision (71.6% Criminal Court; 27% Family Court; 1.4% do both).

1) Caseload Types- Statewide Totals

An FTE is a unit of measure which identifies filled, full-time, annual salaried positions rather than people. For the purpose of the following table, an FTE may be divided into .25 increments to reflect any divided supervision responsibilities. Examples: 1 person in 1 position at 100 percent time (full-time) = 1 FTE, 2 people serving in 2 positions, each at 50 percent time (half-time) = .5 FTE + .5 FTE = 1 FTE, 1 person with a split caseload of 50 percent criminal court Sex Offender Supervision and 50 percent non-supervision duties (therefore not reflected in this table) and 1 person with 100 percent criminal court Sex Offender Supervision duties = 1.5 FTEs in the criminal court sex offender supervision cell. Include ATI and TANF in the "Other" categories and specify in the adjacent yellow cell.
