


**NYS DCJS OPCA  
NYCOMPAS Assessments  
April - June 2011**

- There were 9,374 COMPAS Assessments which included Risk of Violence and Recidivism completed, which was just 9 more than the 9,365 similar assessments completed in the first quarter of 2011.
- There were 8,061 Case Reviews/Reclassifications completed, a 5% increase from 7,683 completed in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2011.
- Pretrial Assessments of the risk of Failure to Appear increased 20% from 1,725 to 2,063.



- **Full COMPAS Assessments** (95 Items) accounted for 66% (6,179) of the 9,374 assessments including Risk of Violence and Recidivism completed during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2011.
- The **Screener Input/Recidivism** scale (39 Items) accounted for 19% (1,754) of these assessments.
- The **Violence & Recidivism w/Substance Abuse** scale (22 Items) accounted for 15% (1,441) of these assessments.

- From January 2010 through June 2011, the number of COMPAS Assessments completed monthly increased 8% from 2,977 to 3,238.
- Case Reviews/Reclassification assessments increased 62% from 1,703 completed monthly to 2,756 over the same 18-month period.

### **County Level Statistics**

- COMPAS assessments were recorded in 57 county probation departments during the second quarter of 2011.
- OPCA guidance indicates probation departments should conduct a Case Review/Reclassification assessment every six months for persons under supervision. There were 16 counties that recorded few or no Case Reviews/Reclassifications completed during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2011.
