Shared Services

- *Shared Services refers to the partnering with other state and local agencies to access treatment and services to reduce criminal justice recidivism for a shared population: individuals who are mentally ill and under criminal justice supervision.*

What are the Goals of the Shared Services Contracts?

- Address revolving door of criminal justice involvement of individuals with serious mental illness including co-occurring substance abuse disorders.
- Encourage collaboration between Mental Health service providers and criminal justice.
- Promote recovery and community integration for participants, including employment.

Shared Services Timeline

2006-2007

Contracts issued further to RFP's for NYC and for selected Counties throughout the State.

2007-2008

Sequential Intercept Mapping accomplished by County contracts.

2009-2011

County contracts renewed at reduced funding.

2011

New contracts issued for NYC further to an RFP.

Shared Services

- Of the 611 participants enrolled in the six programs, 63% (N=382) successfully completed the program between July 1, 2007 and June 30, 2010.
- Overall, among the six programs, 9.2% were re-arrested for a felony within 12 months after exiting the program.
- The 9.2% program felony re-arrest rate is lower than the felony re-arrest rate in the six counties during the same time period, which was about 13%.
